Who we are

SORD — the Sudanese Organisation for Reconstruction & Development — is a Sudanese non-governmental organisation that works under and alongside international NGOs as their implementation partner. We receive funds, deliver programs on the ground through Sudanese teams, and report back to every funder with full transparency. Our teams are local; our accountability is international. SORD is registered at state level, with its head office in Khartoum and branches in Khartoum, Gezira, Gedaref, Red Sea, and White Nile states.

The context we work in

Sudan remains the world's largest displacement crisis. According to the UN Office for the Coordination of Humanitarian Affairs (OCHA), 33.7 million people require humanitarian assistance in 2026 — the highest number in the world — with 9.3 million people internally displaced and a further 4.4 million having fled to neighbouring countries. Access is the defining constraint: much of the deepest need lies in areas that international staff cannot reach. SORD's local teams work where they live, which is why partners fund through us.

Our programs

PROGRAM	WHAT WE DELIVER
Emergency Relief	Food baskets, shelter materials, and medical supplies for crisis-affected families.
Education	School supplies, facilitator training, and safe learning spaces with catch-up classes.
Healthcare	Mobile clinics, essential medicines, and nutrition screening for children under five.
Water & Sanitation	Water point construction and rehabilitation, purification supplies, hygiene infrastructure.
Food Security	Emergency food distribution and support for resilient local food production.
Women's Empowerment	Vocational training, small-business support, and leadership programs.
Child Welfare	Child-friendly safe spaces, psychosocial support, and community-based protection.
Sustainable Development	Livelihoods, community infrastructure, and long-term economic recovery.

How we work

- Partner.** An international NGO funds a program and defines its goals with us.
- Deliver.** SORD teams implement on the ground with local staff and suppliers.
- Report.** Every program is documented and reported back to the funder, with expenditure detail and field documentation.

Where funds went

Of every dollar SORD received in 2025, **89%** went to programs on the ground and **11%** covered operations and fundraising. Our Financial Transparency Statement (published separately) sets out how this allocation is calculated.
