Our commitment

SORD exists so that aid intended for Sudan reaches Sudan. Every funding partner receives itemized budgets, monthly delivery reports, and expenditure detail for each grant. This statement summarises how funds received across all programs in 2025 were allocated.

Allocation of every dollar received in 2025

CATEGORY	SHARE	WHAT IT COVERS
Programs on the ground	89%	Direct program delivery: supplies, local staff and suppliers, transport, distribution, and field documentation.
Operations & fundraising	11%	Administration, finance and compliance, communications, and donor reporting.

How the figure is calculated

- Program costs are expenditures attributable to a specific funded program, including field staff and local procurement.
- Shared costs (office, finance, management) are classified as operations and are not allocated to programs.
- The ratio is calculated across all funds received in the calendar year, not per individual grant.

Per-grant reporting

In addition to this organisation-wide statement, each funding partner receives a monthly delivery report for their grant showing budget, expenditure to date, delivery progress, and status — with receipts and field documentation available on request.
